West Coast Explorer 7 or 8 day Charter Itinerary Available: Mar- Nov

On this 7 or 8 day adventure you will fish the western coast of the Northern Territory. This area is sparsely inhabited with very limited access to the coast, ensuring great fishing.

You will fish the estuaries for Barramundi and Threadfin Salmon and will also do some bait fishing on the reefs for Black Jewfish, Golden Snapper, Coral Trout & Red Emperor to name just a few.

During the cooler months (May-Sept) this area also offers sensational pelagics fishing for Mackerel & Long Tail Tuna.

Day 1 :- Depart Darwin in the afternoon you will steam approximately 100nm heading for Cape Ford at the western end of Anson Bay. Travelling through the afternoon and through the night, the next morning you will be at Cape Ford ready to start fishing.

Day 2 :- Today you will fish the many reef systems around the Cape Ford & Cape Scott area.

Bait fishing this area will produce Golden Snapper, Black Jew Fish, Coral Trout & Red Emperor to name just a few.

Day 3 :- For the next two days you will fish the Dorcherty Creek area and its estuaries; this area consistently produces great Barramundi fishing.

The crab pots will go in these days so Mud Crab will be on the menu.

Day 4/5/6 :- For the next few days you will fish the Moyle & Little Moyle Rivers these rivers produce great barra fishing especially during the Run off months from late Feb to late May.

During the run off you can make the trip to the upper reaches of the Moyle River where you will be greeted by the large flood plains. The fishing around the floodplains can be excitement packed.

Day 7/8 :- Day 7 & 8 will be spent fishing the reefs around & offshore from the Perron Islands.

On these reefs you can encounter nearly all reef species available in the Top End.

The area's offshore from the perrons will also produce sensational pelagic action during or dry season months.

On the evening of the 8th day we will start our trip back to Darwin.

Next morning :- Arrive back in Darwin at approximately 9am

Note: Schedules are subject to change dependant on the prevailing weather conditions at the time. There may be other places visited, more chances to wet a line and many other species encountered than mentioned on the itinerary. For a 7 day charter drop one of the days on the reefs.

Schedules can also be changed to meet you requirements as the charter is in progress.
